

**GALLERY LAUNCH & PREMIERE EXHIBITION:**

**HANNAH WESTWOOD & KLARA OROSZ**  
**EXHIBITION RUNS FROM 15<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER – 31<sup>ST</sup> OCTOBER**

Tenderpixel is a new gallery situated in the heart of Soho, just off St. Martin's Lane. It has been established by Goldsmiths MA alumnus Etan Jonathan Ilfeld, in order to create a space to showcase unique emerging artists on a monthly basis. There will be a focus on conceptual art, however Tenderpixel will also feature forays into design, painting, photography, new media art, video art and sculpture.

From the 15<sup>th</sup> of September until the 31<sup>st</sup> of October, Tenderpixel will showcase Klara Orosz's and Hannah Westwood's most recent creations.

Hannah Westwood is an avant-garde muralist. Working with architectural structures rather than against them, Westwood's installations enforce a second-skin onto their surfaces. Her sexually charged and manga-esque use of transient mediums –such as graphite and chalk –highlights the impermanence of the perversity being played out, in a kind of artistic suicide. Hannah's murals are intricately detailed and juxtapose ornate imagery with minute technophilic symbols.

Klara Orosz's installations have been exhibited in Russia, Hungary, Germany, Croatia, Serbia, and the UK. Her pieces blur the boundaries of life and death while exposing the artificial within the natural –and the natural within the artificial. She is showing two pieces at Tenderpixel –a wood and faux-grass installation that invites the visitor to sit, play and touch, and a hanging display using light and screen technology with natural imagery within.

Both Hannah and Klara have completed their MFA's at Goldsmiths Collage in 2007.
